To my knowledge, there are no pending charges against petitioner that could extend the time to complete the registration requirements of petitioner's tier or change petitioner's tier status.

(b)  Petitioner has not been convicted of a new offense listed in Penal Code section 667.5(c) (violent felonies) since petitioner was released from custody on the offense requiring sex offender registration; and

(c)  The offense for which petitioner is required to register as a sex offender in California

(1) involved no more than one victim 14 through 17 years of age. (2) occurred when petitioner was under 21 years of age, (3) is not one listed in Penal Code section 667.5(c) (except Penal Code section 288(a)), and (4) is not one listed in Penal Code section 236.1.

c.  Tier 3 (*All of the following apply.*)

(1)  Petitioner's designation is based only on a risk-level assessment;

(2)  Petitioner has registered for at least 20 years;

(3)  Petitioner has not been convicted of a new offense requiring sex offender registration since petitioner was released from custody on the offense requiring sex offender registration;

(4)  Petitioner has not been convicted of a new offense listed in Penal Code section 667.5(c) (violent felonies) since petitioner was released from custody on the offense requiring sex offender registration; and

(5)  Petitioner is not required to register for a conviction pursuant to Penal Code section 288 or an offense listed in Penal Code section 1192.7(c) (serious felonies).

The Department of Justice wrote that [REDACTED] tier is "to be determined." However, his sole 1993 Child Molestation in the Second Degree conviction under Washington's RCW 9A.44.086 for which he received a sentence of 6 months in custody with 20 months suspended and 3 years of probation is the equivalent of P.C. 647.6 PC (molesting or disturbing a child under the age of 18) - a Tier 1 offense - or at worst, a Tier 2 offense. In either case, he has surpassed the minimum periods of 10 or 20 years of registration. [REDACTED] has registered for 28 years since his Washington conviction without any re-offense or violation.

P.C. 290.5 was added in 2018 with an effective date of July 1, 2021 to give the DOJ that extended time period time to ascertain the various registrants' tiers. Certainly, the DOJ can determine [REDACTED] tier within the next three months if the Court so orders given that P.C. 290.5 envisions the DOJ to reassess designations in three months for any previously unknown registering convictions. See P.C. 290.5(a)(2).

[REDACTED] is a zero risk to re-offend per a recent psychological evaluation conducted by Los Angeles Superior Court expert panel member forensic psychologist Dr. Nadim Karim that satisfies P.C. 290.5(a)(3): [REDACTED] Static-99-R score is -1, his Stable-2007 score is 0 and his LS/CMI score is 0. He is not a threat to the community and satisfies the requirements to grant this petition regardless if viewed as a Tier 1, 2 or 3 (low risk).

It is important to also note that the same Washington Superior Court that convicted him, terminated his Washington registration requirements on November 22, 2013, after 15 years of registration. (See attached Washington Superior Court order).

Given the above, a hearing and granting of [REDACTED] petition to terminate his California registration requirements is respectfully requested.
